Murphy earned a bachelor of fine arts degree from the International Academy of Design and Technology and a master's degree in communications from Johns Hopkins University.

Gibbs earned a bachelor's degree in business administration and marketing from Bowie State University and a master's degree in of business administration from Morgan State University.
